****PLEASE READ THE REVERSE SIDE OF APPLICATION FOR
2007 TOURNAMENT CHANGES & RULES****

- The Tournament Committee will consist of a minimum of 6 representatives from a combination of individuals associated with, Sterling Farms & E. Gaynor Brennan Golf Courses, The Metropolitan Golf Association and The PGA of America, of which none will be eligible to play in the tournament.
- The entry deadline is 2 weeks prior to first date of play. The entry fee is non-refundable.
- Only the first 192 players returning their fully completed registration form with full payment will be guaranteed entry. Entries will be marked with the date of receipt to determine priority, in the event more than 192 entries are received. The tournament Committee, in its sole discretion, will determine if more than 192 players can participate.
- Starting times will be determined from a blind draw at a public draw party open to all Stamford Amateur Golf Championship participants the Sunday after entries close at 5:00 pm at the golf course which will be hosting the finals.
- Assuming a maximum of 192 players, all play will be on one course each day. The first groups will tee off from the 1st and 10th tees from 6:30 am to 8:30 am every 10 minutes. The second groups will tee off from the 1st and 10th tees from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm every 10 minutes. All players for their 2 qualifying rounds will have 1 starting time between 6:30 am and 8:30 am and 1 starting time between 11:30 am and 1:30 pm.
- A minimum of 10 scores must be recorded during the Metropolitan Golf Association's 2007 season to be eligible to participate.
- Participation in the tournament will be governed by USGA rules including, but not limited to, pace of play, handicap adjustment, rules interpretation, disqualification, etc.
- ***The Tournament Committee will review handicaps to determine if adjustments are merited for tournament play based upon all USGA criteria. The Tournament committee will check to determine if participants have posted all golf scores prior to the tournament correctly. Any golfer submitting an incorrect score, or failing to post a score, or failing to designate a prior score as a tournament score when participating in a tournament, shall be subject to disqualification. Any information provided to the Tournament Committee concerning an improper handicap will be reviewed and investigated thoroughly. Any infractions of USGA rules discovered by the Tournament Committee will result in enforcement action, including, but not limited to, disqualification.***
- The Tournament Committee shall seed golfers in flights after receiving and reviewing the registrations. The Tournament Committee will determine the number of flights, the number of golfers in each flight, the number of golfers who qualify for the final round and the prizes awarded in each flight. The Tournament Committee's determination, however, will be based upon a percentage applied uniformly to all flights. For example, the Tournament Committee may determine that 30% of the golfers will qualify. That means that 30% (plus ties) will qualify in each flight regardless of the number of participants. Prizes will be awarded based upon the number of participants in each flight.
- Both courses will offer a special cart rate of \$13 per person for 2 carts in a foursome. If an individual drives alone it will cost only \$13 provided there are only 2 carts in a foursome. If an individual chooses to drive his/her own cart because he/she does not want to share a cart, and 2 carts have already been rented for that foursome, then that golfer will be charged the full rate.
- If a participant qualifies for and is unable to play the final round, and fails to notify the Tournament Committee prior to 7:00 pm on the first Sunday of play, then that player may be prohibited by the Tournament Committee, in its sole discretion, from participating in the following year's event.
- Starting times are the sole responsibility of the applicant. If the applicant is late for their posted starting time they will be penalized 2 shots (up to 5 minutes late only) and they will be allowed to join their assigned group or will be disqualified if they are more than 5 minutes late and not be allowed to play the following day.
